



Wall Mounted Type B Clinical Basin w/ No Tap Hole Offset Waste No Overflow





Wall Mounted Type B Clinical Basin w/ One Tap Hole Offset Waste No Overflow






Wall Mounted Type A Clinical Basin w/ Nano Glazing, No Tap Hole Offset Waste No Overflow





Wall Mounted Type A Clinical Basin w/ Nano Glazing, One Tap Hole Offset Waste No Overflow





Installation Steps

IMPORTANT

Provide suitable reinforcement behind the finished wall to allow fixing kit at the mounting height position.

- Remove the basin from the carton and inspect for any transport damage. If the product is damaged do not proceed with the installation.
- Mark fixing screw hole position on the finished wall as per dimensions; Note: This product has an offset waste.
- For masonry wall drill 2 x 12mm holes for expansion fasteners, For timber stud wall drill 2 x 8mm holes for fixing screws and ensure they are leveled.
- Using the flat section of the screw with a spanner ensure to tighten and allow 40mm of thread from the finished wall.
- Place the basin onto the fixing screws, insert the nylon flange washers and backing washers then tighten the nuts, ensure to level off the basin before complete fastening.
- It is recommended to finish off installation with silicon beading between the basin and the wall.
- 7. Assemble taps and waste fittings to the basin.

Optional Shroud

- The shroud bracket (supplied) fixed to the wall.
- 2. Secure the basin and connect plumbing.
- Locate the bracket in position and double check. The bracket and shroud should line up then mount the bracket.
- Position the shroud beneath the basin and locate the bracket hole with the bracket. Screw the fixing bolt into shroud and bracket, and tighten with an Allen Key (not supplied).

IMPORTANT: DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN, THIS MAY RESULT IN SHROUD DAMAGE.

5. Check shroud is level and secured with basin with no apparent gap.


